LETTER OF CONDEMNATION AND CONDOLENCE

Dated Aizawl, the 14th May, 2026

The Mizoram Presbyterian Church expresses its profound shock and sorrow over the brutal attack on the 13th May, 2026 in Kangpokpi District, Manipur that claimed the lives of three devoted members of the Thadou Baptist Association India (TBAI) - Rev. Kaigoulun Lhouvum, Rev. Dr. Vumthang Sithou and Pastor Paogoulen Sithou who dedicated their lives to spiritual guidance and communal peace. Several other believers and church workers were also injured in this incident.

The Mizoram Synod denounces this senseless act of violence in the strongest terms. The victims were defenseless religious leaders carrying out their sacred duties of worship and ministry. Their deaths have brought immense grief and pain to the entire Christian community. We strongly condemn the heinous act of violence in the strongest possible terms. No cause or grievance can ever justify the taking of innocent lives especially those who dedicated themselves to spiritual guidance, compassion and service to society. Attacks upon the religious leaders are attacks upon the very principles of peace, unity and mutual respect that hold communities together.

During this hour of immense grief, the Mizoram Synod conveys its deepest sympathy and condolences to the families who have lost their loved ones and to the congregation affected by this incident. We assure them of our prayers and unwavering support as they mourn.

We earnestly call upon all parties to the conflict to lay down their arms and seek the path of peace and reconciliation through our Lord Jesus Christ. Let us choose forgiveness over vengeance and healing over hatred.
